NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE
AND NECESSITY (CCN) TO PROVIDE WATER
UTILITY SERVICE IN COLLIN COUNTY

City of Parker has filed an application to decertify a portion of CCN No. 10207 with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to provide water utility service in Collin County.

The proposed utility service area to be decertified is located approximately 5 miles east of downtown Plano, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Parker Rd.; on the east by FM 1378; on the south by FM 544; and on the west by Jupiter Rd. The total proposed area to be decertified is approximately 1400 acres.

A copy of the proposed area map is available at the City of Parker, 5700 E. Parker Road, Parker, Texas 75002 and Phone Number 972/442-6811.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

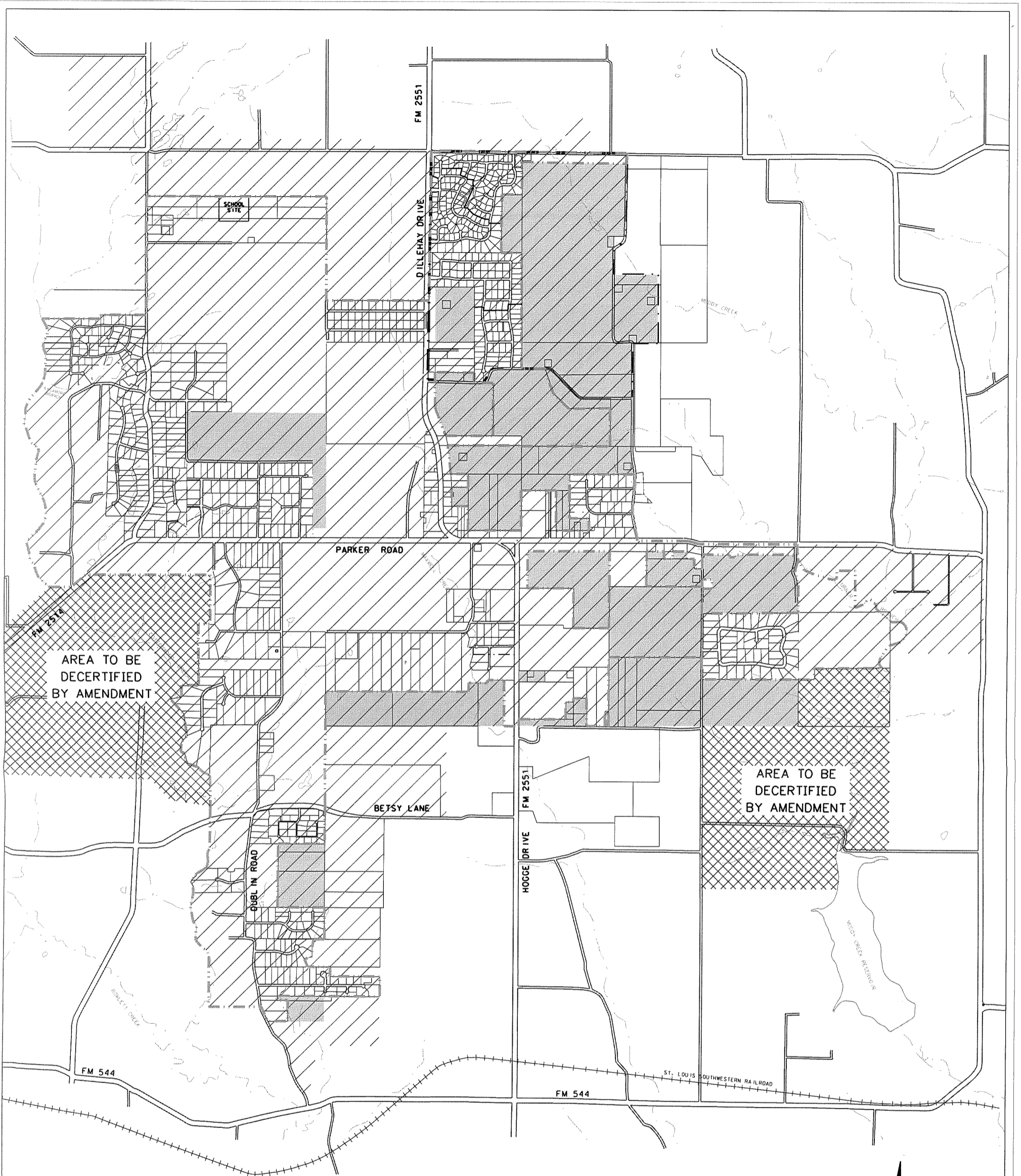

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.








If a public hearing is requested, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAR) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

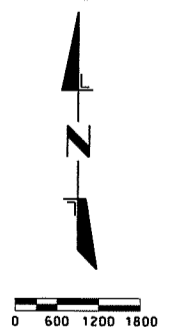
